

Dr Evagoras Economides graduated from the English School Nicosia in 1986 with top honours. Subsequently, he completed his military training and was awarded a Commonwealth Scholarship to study medicine at Cambridge University (Robinson College), UK. Having been awarded a First Class Honours Bachelor's Degree in Medical Sciences in 1991 he was also a recipient of the Warden's prize as the "most outstanding Robinson College, Cambridge Graduate". Dr. Economides completed his medical studies at the University of Oxford between 1991 and 1994. During that time he was a scholar of the Leventis Foundation and a Senior Scholar of Merton College, Oxford.

Following a pre-registration training in Glasgow and Newcastle, he emigrated to the United States of America for further training. Dr. Economides trained in: Internal Medicine at the University of Albany Medical Center (New York), Cardiology at Georgetown University Medical School (Washington DC) and heart failure at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. He also holds sub-specialty certifications in Echocardiography and Nuclear Cardiology.

After completing his training, he worked as a Consultant Cardiologist and Partner at Cardiology Consultants, Delaware, the largest cardiology group in the State from 2001 to 2004. In the duration of that period he also acted as the Head of the Non-invasive division of the Cardiology Department at Beebe Hospital, Delaware.

Dr. Economides returned to Cyprus, in 2004 and became an associate at the American Heart Institute, Nicosia until 2006. Henceforth, he joined Aretaeio Hospital where he practices cardiology ever since.

In 2011, he was also appointed as a member of Faculty at the first Medical School in Cyprus (St. George's of London Medical School, at the University of Nicosia). There he held the position of Senior Lecturer until 2018 when he was promoted to Associate Professor of Medicine.

From 2016 to 2018 he acted as president to the Echocardiography Working Group of the Cyprus Cardiology Society.

Dr Economides continues to this day practice cardiology at Aretaeio Hospital and teach at the Medical school. His special interests are Cardiac Imaging, Heart Failure and Arrhythmias.
